Our Mobile Meal program provides nutritionally balanced meals for homebound seniors who are not able to provide themselves with a homecooked meal.

LIBRARY TO GO

We partner with Victoria Public Library to deliver library items and crafts to our homebound clients.

TOGETHERNESS

Our Togetherness program aims to lessen the isolation and loneliness homebound adults can experience by creating opportunities to build social connections and friendships through weekly calls and/or visits.

CONNECTION CAFE

Our Congregate Meal program provides a nutritionally balanced lunch and daily activities every weekday.

Monday - Friday, 9:30 AM - 12:30 PM at the Connection Cafe. BINGO Tuesday & Thursday, 10:00 AM.

Monday - Friday, 10:00 AM - 1:00 PM at our Yorktown location. Meals served at 11:30 AM. Meal Reservations must be made 48 hours in advance.

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Spooky Cupcakes

QUICK AND EASY RECIPE

Ingredients:

- 1 cup pumpkin puree
- · 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 cup sugar
- 1/2 cup brown sugar
- · 2 tsp pumpkin spice
- 1 tsp cinnamon
- 1/2 tsp nutmeg
- 1 tsp baking powder
- 1/2 tsp baking soda
- 1/2 tsp salt
- 1/2 cup vegetable oil
- · 2 large eggs
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- Whipped cream or white frosting
- Chocolate chips (for eyes)

Steps for Cooking:

- Preheat oven to 350°F. Line a muffin tin with cupcake liners.
- In a large bowl, mix together flour, sugars, pumpkin spice, cinnamon, nutmeg, baking powder, baking soda, and salt. In another bowl, whisk together pumpkin puree, oil, eggs, and vanilla extract. Mix.
- Fill cupcake liners 3/4 full and bake for 18-20 minutes, or until a toothpick inserted into the center comes out clean.
- Top with whipped cream or white frosting, swirling it to create a ghost shape. Place two chocolate chips as eyes on each ghost.

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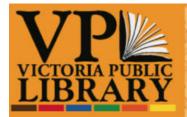

REMEMBER TO RENEW

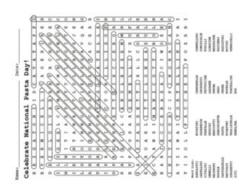
You must renew your enrollment in our services each year. You will receive the notice for renewal (at right) by mail, about a month before your enrollment expires.
